**A personal pronoun replaces a noun as the subject of a sentence.**

Example: Michael likes ice cream. → He likes ice cream.

Example: The computer is new. → It is new.

**An object pronoun replaces a noun as the object of a sentence.**

Example: Jane loves Joe. → Jane loves him.

Example: Give the books to the boys. → Give the books to them.

**Possessive adjectives show possession or ownership and go before the noun they modify.**

Example: That is my folder.

Example: Your dog is very big.

My name is Sue. (Sue) \_\_\_\_\_ am English. And this is my family.

My mum's name is Angie. (Angie) \_\_\_\_\_ is from Germany.

Bob is my dad. (My dad) \_\_\_\_\_ is a waiter.

On the left you can see Simon. (Simon) \_\_\_\_\_ is my brother.

(Sue and Simon) \_\_\_\_\_ are twins.

My sister Jane loves books. This novel is for \_\_\_\_\_ (she).

My children like Disney films. The video is for \_\_\_\_\_ (they).

My brother Matt collects picture postcards. These postcards are for \_\_\_\_\_ (he).

My parents like Latin music. The CD is for \_\_\_\_\_ (they).

I like watches. This nice watch is for \_\_\_\_\_ (I).

Here is a postcard from (I) \_\_\_\_\_ friend Peggy.
